A standout collegiate athlete under Coach Brian Kelly at Grand Valley State, Kircus helped lead his team to a national championship and set multiple NCAA records at the wide receiver position. Since earning his master's degree in Kinesiology (Sports Management) from LSU with honors, Kircus has spent the past three years actively contributing to the LSU football program—supporting recruiting efforts, assisting with on-field technical instruction during summer camps, and mentoring student-athletes through their personal and athletic development.
