Biography

Mark Brunell enters his fourth season as the Lions' quarterbacks coach in 2024. In 2023, he helped QB Jared Goff lead the NFL in passing first downs (227), rank second in passing yards (4,575) and rank fourth in passing touchdowns (30) en route to the team capturing their first division title since 1993 and advancing to their second-ever NFC Championship Game.
